Preamble

Activities of HICC

The HICC will supervise the implementation of the hospital infection control programme.

Specifically, the committee shall

1. **Educating** Institute nurses, MBBS students, intern, residents and other staffs about principles of infection control and stressing individual responsibility for Infection Control.
2. **Surveillance**
 - a. Hospital Acquired infection (HAI) Surveillance- Develops a system for identifying, reporting, analyzing, investigation and controlling hospital acquired infections.
 - b. Antimicrobial Resistance (AMR) Surveillance
 - c. Environmental Surveillance (Air, Water, Surface- OTs/ICUs and other high risk area
 - d. Staff skin flora Surveillance
3. **Disinfectants**
 - a. To check for sterilization & disinfection practices in the Institute
 - b. In-use test of disinfectants
4. **Outbreak Investigation**
 - a. Continuous surveillance of infections for early detection of outbreak for which, appropriate control measures are undertaken.
 - b. Surveillance of any community outbreak viz. Dengue, meningitis, diphtheria, meningococemia etc. to prevent spread within the hospital amongst health care workers.
5. **Monitoring Hospital Biomedical Waste Management**- In collaboration with the Biomedical Waste Management department, HICC aims at monitoring the waste segregation and disposal system
6. **Auditing**-HICC conducts regular audits for various aspects such as
 - a. Hand Hygiene audit
 - b. BMW (Biomedical Waste Management) audit
7. **Needle Stick Injury Reporting System**- In collaboration with Member Secretary, HICC regularly monitors the Needle stick Injury reporting system which involves
 - a. Reporting of Needle stick Injuries
 - b. Testing the serum of health care workers and the source for HIV/HBV/HCV.
 - c. Timely administration of appropriate ART if needed



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8. **Staff Health Care Activities**-are carried out with the objectives:
 - a. Vaccinating all the staffs/students (especially freshly recruited) of the Institute with Hepatitis B vaccine
 - b. Regular check of Anti HBs antibody titre of all the staffs/students of Institute.
 - c. Attending all needle stick injured staffs and taking preventive measures- as described above
 - d. Monitoring and investigating potentially harmful infectious exposures and outbreaks among hospital staffs
 - e. Continuous training and ongoing education is carried out for freshly recruited staffs/students.
 - f. Identifying work-related infection risks and instituting appropriate preventive measures.
9. **Monitors the proper use of antibiotics**, develops antibiotic policies and recommend remedial measures when antibiotic resistant strains are detected.
10. **Reporting of Notifiable Diseases** with collaboration with department of PSM.
11. **Prepare the manuals** for hospital infection control as well as antimicrobial guideline and review and update hospital infection control policies and procedures from time to time.
12. **Meets regularly** as per norms.

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
